handle, separate or arrange ballot papers;
 - (c) 干擾或企圖干擾任何投票箱、選票結算書、選票結算核實書或覆核書、或其他有關的選舉物料；或
interfere with or attempt to interfere with any ballot boxes, ballot paper accounts, verifications or re-verifications of such accounts or other relevant election materials; or
 - (d) 在點票過程拍影片、拍照、錄音或錄影。
take film, photograph or make any audio or video recording during the counting process.

8. *本人／我們每人亦清楚明白，倘*本人／我們在點票站內或其附近行爲不檢，或不服從投票站主任的任何合法指示，即屬違法，可被判罰款及監禁，並可能會被投票站主任命令立即離開該地方。倘*本人／我們沒有離開，可能會被警務人員或任何其他經書面授權人員帶離該地方。*本人／我們被帶離後，除非獲得投票站主任的許可，否則不得再次進入點票站。

*I/Each of us also understand(s) that if *I/we misconduct *myself/ourselves at or in the vicinity of the counting station, or fail to obey any lawful order of the Presiding Officer, *I/we shall commit an offence punishable with a fine and imprisonment and may be ordered by the Presiding Officer to leave the area immediately. *My/Our failure to leave the area may result in *my/our being removed by a police officer or by any other person so authorized in writing. If *I/we are so removed, *I/we may not re-enter the counting station except with the permission of the Presiding Officer.

Notes on Completion of Notice of Appointment of Counting Agents

1. 除非候選人以指明表格明文另作示明，有關代理人須當作是為在預定日期進行的投票中或（如適用的話）遭押後或延期的該次投票中所投的票的點算而委任。

The agent is to be regarded as being appointed for the counting of the votes cast in the poll to be conducted on the scheduled date and (where applicable) the postponed or adjourned poll, unless the candidate expressly indicates otherwise in the specified form.

2. 候選人或其選舉代理人可在該候選人獲提名的選區內，就每個點票站委任不超過 2 名監察點票代理人。凡年滿 18 歲的香港身分證持有人均可被委任為監察點票代理人。任何人可被委任為多於一個點票站的監察點票代理人，但該候選人或選舉代理人須分別就每一個點票站填寫一份委任通知書。候選人或其選舉代理人不應委任任何選舉主任、助理選舉主任、或任何已受總選舉事務主任委任協助進行投票或點票的人士（通常為政府公職人員）為其監察點票代理人。

A candidate or his election agent may appoint not more than 2 counting agents for each counting station in respect of the constituency for which the candidate is nominated. Any person who is a holder of a Hong Kong Identity Card and has attained the age of 18 years may be appointed as a counting agent. A person can be appointed as a counting agent for more than one counting station but separate notices should be given in respect of each counting station. However, a candidate or his election agent should ensure that he does not appoint as his counting agent any Returning Officer, Assistant Returning Officer, or any person (usually a Government officer) already appointed by the Chief Electoral Officer to assist at the poll or at the count.

3. 本通知書的第一部分應由候選人或選舉代理人填寫及簽署。第二部分應由各個監察點票代理人填寫及簽署。

Part I of the notice should be completed and signed by the candidate or the election agent. Part II should be completed and signed by each of the counting agents.

4. 委任監察點票代理人的委任通知書，須於投票日 7 天前（即 2009 年 3 月 22 日或之前）由專人送遞或以郵遞或圖文傳真方式送交有關的選舉主任，或於投票日由候選人或選舉代理人親自向監察點票代理人所負責的點票站的投票站主任遞交。逾期遞交的通知將不予接納。監察點票代理人的委任，在選舉主任或投票站主任（視何者屬適當而定）接獲委任通知書後始生效。

Notice of appointment of counting agents shall either be delivered to the relevant Returning Officer by hand or by post or by facsimile transmission at least 7 days before the polling day (i.e. by 22 March 2009), or be given by the candidate or the election agent in person to the Presiding Officer for the counting station for which the counting agents are appointed on the polling day. Late submissions will not be accepted. The appointment of counting agents will not be effective until the notice of appointment is received by the Returning Officer or the Presiding Officer, as may be appropriate.

(a) **資料用途**

就此通知書提供的個人及其他有關的資料，會供選舉事務處、選舉主任及投票站主任用於與選舉有關的用途。

Purpose of Collection

The personal data and other related information supplied in connection with this notice will be used by the Registration and Electoral Office, the Returning Officer and the Presiding Officer for election-related purposes.

Access to Personal Data

A person has the right to request access to and correction of the personal data he supplied in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486).
