

Hearing Arrangements under Typhoon and Rainstorm Warning

When Tropical Cyclone Signal No. 8 or above, an “Extreme Condition” announcement or a black rainstorm warning signal is issued or cancelled, the Registry for Appeals will arrange the adjournment and resumption of hearings according to the following conditions:

When Pre-No. 8 Special Announcement is issued between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.

In general, when Pre-No. 8 Special Announcement is issued between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., the hearings scheduled in the morning session will be adjourned until further notice.

When Tropical Cyclone Signal No. 8 or above is issued

In general, when Tropical Cyclone Signal No. 8 or above is issued, the scheduled hearings will be adjourned.

When Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued

In general, when a black rainstorm warning signal is issued before office opening hour (i.e. 9:00 a.m.), the scheduled hearings will be adjourned.

When Tropical Cyclone Signal No. 8 or above, “Extreme Condition” announcement or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is lowered or cancelled

- If the signal is lowered or cancelled at or before 6:00 a.m., hearings will be held as scheduled.
- If the signal is lowered or cancelled between 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. or at 11:00 a.m., hearings to be commenced at 2:00 p.m. will be conducted as scheduled.
- If the signal is lowered or cancelled after 11:00 a.m., all scheduled hearings will be adjourned for the whole day.

The Registry for Appeals will notify all concerned parties of the re-scheduled hearings in due course.
