EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR COMPLETING A NOTICE OF OBJECTION REGARDING REGISTRATION FOR FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES/ ELECTION COMMITTEE SUBSECTORS

1. This Notice of Objection should be used for lodging an objection if you consider that any registered person (i.e. individual or body whose particulars are recorded in the functional constituencies provisional register or the subsector provisional register):

- (a) is not eligible to be registered:
 - (i) as an elector, a voter or an authorized representative; or
 - (ii) in the part (i.e. the functional constituency or subsector) in which that individual/body's particulars are recorded; or
- (b) who has been registered as an authorized representative has been wrongly so registered.

2. A separate Notice of Objection in the specified form must be used for each individual/body being objected to.

3. You should state the grounds in support of your objection in this Notice. While not attempting to be exhaustive, the following are some examples:

- (a) the person whose registration as an elector, voter or authorized representative is being objected to is not a permanent resident of Hong Kong, does not ordinarily reside in Hong Kong or does not satisfy the age requirement, or the person or body does not possess the necessary qualifications for registration as an elector in the relevant functional constituency or a voter in the relevant subsector;
- (b) the person whose registration as an elector, voter or authorized representative is being objected to is disqualified from being registered as an elector for a geographical constituency for:
 - (i) having been found under the Mental Health Ordinance (Cap. 136) to be incapable, by reason of mental incapacity, of managing and administering his/her property and affairs; or
 - (ii) being a member of the armed forces of the Central People's Government or any other country or territory;
- (c) the person whose registration as an authorized representative is being objected to does not have a substantial connection with the corporate elector or corporate voter;
- (d) the body whose registration as an elector or voter is being objected to is disqualified from being registered as an elector or voter for:

- (i) being a consular post to which any privilege or immunity is accorded under the Consular Relations Ordinance (Cap. 557); or
- (ii) being an organization to which section 2 of the International Organizations and Diplomatic Privileges Ordinance (Cap. 190) applies or an international organization defined in section 2 of the International Organizations (Privileges and Immunities) Ordinance (Cap. 558); or
- (iii) being a department or an agency of a government of a place outside the People's Republic of China, whether at national, regional or municipal level.

You must provide sufficient information about the objection so as to inform the Revising Officer, the Electoral Registration Officer and the person/body being objected to of the grounds of the objection.

4. You must provide a copy of this Notice and any written representations to the person/body being objected to¹. The information provided by you may also be provided to organizations/persons concerned for the purposes of voter registration, election and all related purposes where necessary.

5. “Principal residential address”, in relation to a person, means the address of the only or principal residence (within the meaning of section 28(1B) or (3) of the Legislative Council Ordinance (Cap. 542)) of that person.

6. You must deliver this Notice in person² to the office of the Electoral Registration Officer at the following address on or before 25 August 2022³:

¹ According to section 2B of the Registration of Electors (Appeals) Regulation (Cap. 542B) or section 3B of the Election Committee (Registration) (Voters for Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) (Appeals) Regulation (Cap. 569B), an appellant must provide sufficient information about the objection concerned to inform the person in respect of whom the objection is made of the grounds of the objection and the information may be provided in the notice of objection.

² If you are in custody within the meaning of section 2(1) of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Electoral Procedure) (Legislative Council) Regulation (Cap. 541D), you may deliver this Notice by post, through your penal institution or the relevant law enforcement agency, to the office of the Electoral Registration Officer. Being “in custody” means you are (a) serving a sentence of imprisonment, (b) detained by the Correctional Services Department on remand, or (c) otherwise detained by any law enforcement agency under any lawful authority. Law enforcement agency means (a) the Customs and Excise Department, (b) the Hong Kong Police Force, (c) the Immigration Department, (d) the Independent Commission Against Corruption, or (e) any other department of the Government of which any officer is empowered by any Ordinance to exercise a power of arrest.

7. If the person making the objection is a body, this Notice should be signed on its behalf by a **responsible person** of that body and must be **delivered** to the Electoral Registration Officer **by that person**. A responsible person is a person authorized by a body for this purpose.

8. The Electoral Registration Officer may require you to identify yourself by presenting your Hong Kong identity card or passport. You should therefore bring your Hong Kong identity card or passport with you when you deliver this Notice.

9. The Electoral Registration Officer will forward your objection to the Revising Officer for his determination. The Revising Officer will be the Registrar of the High Court, or a magistrate or a legal officer appointed by the Chief Justice.

10. The Revising Officer will, by notice, inform you and the person/body being objected to of the date (which will be **between 29 August 2022 and 11 September 2022** in respect of Notices received by the Electoral Registration Officer **on or before 25 August 2022**), time and place for holding a hearing as regards the objection to which the relevant Notice relates. Both you **and the person/body being objected to** may appear at the hearing either in person or be represented by a legal practitioner or any other person (authorized in writing by you or the person/body being objected to). Whether or not you appear or are represented at the hearing, you may make written representations to the Revising Officer, which should reach him not later than 1 day before the date of the hearing. This arrangement also applies to the person/body being objected to.

11. If you do not appear and are not represented at the hearing, and do not make written representations to the Revising Officer not later than 1 day before the date of the hearing, and the Electoral Registration Officer does not make representations to the Revising Officer at the hearing, the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer to which your Notice relates shall stand. **The Revising Officer may dismiss your objection directly if you or your authorized person does not attend the hearing of the relevant objection.**

12. To facilitate the parties concerned to attend hearings and enable the relevant parties and members of the public to obtain information about the hearings as soon as possible, the Electoral Registration Officer will upload the relevant information in respect of your objection on this Office website (www.reo.gov.hk), including your name (i.e. the objector), the name of the person⁴/body being objected to, the case number, date and time of hearing. The relevant information will be removed from this

13. The Electoral Registration Officer will request the Revising Officer to determine your claim on the basis of written submissions only when the Notice of Objection does not state any ground on which the objection is made; the Notice of Objection does not state a ground on which the objection is made that concerns the eligibility of a registered person; the subject matter of the objection involves only a clerical error. The Revising Officer must direct that the relevant objection be determined without a hearing on the basis of written submissions only. You or the person/body being objected to could request a review of the ruling if you or the person/body being objected to are not satisfied with the Revising Officer's ruling.

14. These notes are for general guidance only. You should also refer to the Legislative Council Ordinance (Cap. 542), the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569), the Electoral Affairs Commission Ordinance (Cap. 541) and the relevant subsidiary legislation. The relevant legislation can be found on the Hong Kong e-legislation website (www.elegislation.gov.hk) and is on sale at the Publications Sales Unit of the Information Services Department.

16. **Offences and Penalties**

Pursuant to section 42(1) of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) Regulation (Cap. 541B), any person who in any Notice of Objection makes any statement which the person knows to be false in a material particular or recklessly makes any statement which is incorrect in a material particular or knowingly omits any material particular from such a notice commits an offence and is liable on conviction on indictment to a fine at level 3 and to imprisonment for 2 years.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Purpose of Collection

The personal data and other related information provided by you by means of this Notice will be used by the Registration and Electoral Office for voter registration and election-related purposes. The provision of personal data and other related information by means of this Notice is entirely voluntary. However, if you do not provide adequate and accurate data, this Office may not be able to process your Notice.

Transfer of Information

The information provided by you will be provided to the Revising Officer, and where necessary may also be provided to other authorized departments/organizations/persons for the purposes of voter registration, election and all purposes related thereto in accordance with the relevant Ordinances and/or subsidiary legislation.

Access to Personal Data and Enquiry

You have the right to request access to and to request the correction of the personal data and other related information you supplied in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486). Such personal data requests and enquiries should be made in writing to the Electoral Registration Officer (Address: 10th Floor, Harbour Centre, 25 Harbour Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong).
