## **EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR COMPLETING A NOTICE OF OBJECTION REGARDING REGISTRATION AS MEMBER OF ELECTION COMMITTEE**

1. If you consider that any registered person whose particulars are recorded in the provisional register of members of the Election Committee is not eligible to be registered:
  - (a) as a member; or
  - (b) in the section (i.e. the subsector) in which that person's particulars are recorded,you should use this Notice of Objection to lodge an objection.
2. A separate Notice of Objection in the specified form must be used for each member being objected to.
3. You should state the ground(s) in support of your objection in this Notice. While not attempting to be exhaustive, the following are some examples:
  - (a) the person being objected to whose name and relevant particulars should be omitted from the provisional register by the Electoral Registration Office for the following reasons:
    - (i) being dead;
    - (ii) having resigned, or being deemed to have resigned from the Election Committee under section 3 of the Schedule to the Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569); or
    - (iii) having ceased to be registered or eligible to be registered, or having been disqualified from being registered as an elector for a geographical constituency under the Legislative Council Ordinance (Cap. 542);
  - (b) the person being objected to is not eligible to be registered as an elector for a geographical constituency because he/she is not a permanent resident of Hong Kong, does not ordinarily reside in Hong Kong or does not satisfy the age requirement etc.; or
  - (c) the person being objected to is disqualified from being registered as an elector for a geographical constituency for:
    - (i) having been found under the Mental Health Ordinance (Cap. 136) to be incapable, by reason of mental incapacity, of managing and administering his/her property and affairs; or
    - (ii) being a member of the armed forces of the Central People's Government or any other country or territory.

**You must provide sufficient information about the objection so as to inform the Revising Officer, the Electoral Registration Officer and the person being objected to of the ground(s) of the objection.**

4. You must provide a copy of this Notice and any written representations to the person being objected to<sup>1</sup>. The information provided by you may also be provided to the persons concerned for the purposes of voter registration, election and all related purposes where necessary.

5. “Principal residential address”, in relation to a person, means the address of the only or principal residence (within the meaning of section 28(1B) or (3) of the Legislative Council Ordinance (Cap. 542)) of that person.

6. You must deliver this Notice **in person**<sup>2</sup> to the office of the Electoral Registration Officer at the following address **on or before 16 June 2025**<sup>3</sup>:

7. The Electoral Registration Officer may require you to identify yourself by presenting your Hong Kong identity card or passport. You should therefore bring your Hong Kong identity card or passport with you when you deliver this Notice.

8. The Electoral Registration Officer will forward your objection to the Revising Officer for his/her determination. The Revising Officer will be the Registrar of the High Court, or a magistrate or a legal

<sup>1</sup> According to section 3B of the Election Committee (Registration) (Voters for Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) (Appeals) Regulation (Cap. 569B), an appellant must provide sufficient information about the objection concerned to inform the person in respect of whom the objection is made of the grounds of the objection and the information may be provided in the notice of objection.

<sup>2</sup> If you are in custody within the meaning of section 2(1) of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Electoral Procedure) (Legislative Council) Regulation (Cap. 541D), you may deliver this Notice by post, through your penal institution or the relevant law enforcement agency, to the office of the Electoral Registration Officer. Being “in custody” means you are (a) serving a sentence of imprisonment, (b) detained by the Correctional Services Department on remand, or (c) otherwise detained by any law enforcement agency under any lawful authority. Law enforcement agency means (a) the Customs and Excise Department, (b) the Hong Kong Police Force, (c) the Immigration Department, (d) the Independent Commission Against Corruption, or (e) any other department of the Government of which any officer is empowered by any Ordinance to exercise a power of arrest.

officer appointed by the Chief Justice.

9. The Revising Officer will, by notice, inform you and the person being objected to of the date (which will be **between 12 June 2025 and 29 June 2025** in respect of Notices received by the Electoral Registration Officer **on or before 16 June 2025**), time and place for holding a hearing as regards the objection to which the relevant Notice relates. Both you and the person being objected to may appear in person at the hearing and make representations to the Revising Officer; or may be represented at the hearing by a legal practitioner or any other person (authorized in writing by you or the person being objected to) who may make representations on your behalf or on behalf of the person being objected to. Whether or not you appear or are represented at the hearing, you may make representations in writing and submit them, by post or by hand, to the Revising Officer. The written representations should reach the Revising Officer on a date not later than 1 day before the date of the hearing. This arrangement also applies to the person being objected to.

10. Pursuant to section 3 of the Election Committee (Registration) (Voters for Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) (Appeals) Regulation (Cap. 569B), if the Electoral Registration Officer does not make representations to the Revising Officer at the hearing, and you (1) do not appear at the hearing; (2) are not represented by a legal practitioner or any other person (authorized in writing by you); and (3) do not make representations in writing to be received by the Revising Officer on a date not later than 1 day before the date of the hearing, the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer to which your Notice relates shall stand. **If you do not appear at the hearing, and are not represented at the hearing by a legal practitioner or any other person (authorized in writing by you), the Revising Officer may make a ruling dismissing the objection, whether or not you have made representations in writing regarding the objection.**

11. To facilitate the parties concerned to attend hearings and enable the relevant parties and members of the public to obtain information about the hearings as soon as possible, the Electoral Registration Officer will upload the relevant information in respect of your objection on this Office website ([www.reo.gov.hk](http://www.reo.gov.hk)), including your name (i.e. the objector), the name of the person being objected to<sup>4</sup>, the case number, date, time and place of hearing. The relevant information will be removed from this Office website after 29 June 2025.

12. These notes are for general guidance only. You should also refer to the Electoral Affairs Commission Ordinance (Cap. 541), the Legislative Council Ordinance (Cap. 542), Chief Executive Election Ordinance (Cap. 569) and the relevant subsidiary legislation. <sup>4</sup> The name of the person being objected to uploaded to the Registration and Electoral Office website will follow the presentation prescribed in section 29(4A) of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) Regulation (Cap. 541B)[ i.e. the first Chinese character of the name (if the person's name is recorded in Chinese) or the first word of the name (if the person's name is recorded in English) will be shown.]

### **Offences and Penalties**

14. Pursuant to section 42(1) of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) Regulation (Cap. 541B), any person who in any Notice of Objection makes any statement which the person knows to be false in a material particular or recklessly makes any statement which is incorrect in a material particular or knowingly omits any material particular from such a notice commits an offence and is liable on conviction on indictment to a fine at level 3 and to imprisonment for 2 years.

## **Personal Information Collection Statement**

### **Purpose of Collection**

The personal data and other related information provided by you by means of this Notice will be used by the Registration and Electoral Office for voter registration and election-related purposes. The provision of personal data and other related information by means of this Notice is entirely voluntary. However, if you do not provide adequate and accurate data, this Office may not be able to process your Notice.

### **Transfer of Information**

The information provided by you will be provided to the Revising Officer, and where necessary may also be provided to other authorized departments/organizations/persons for the purposes of voter registration, election and all purposes related thereto in accordance with the relevant Ordinances and/or subsidiary legislation.

### **Access to Personal Data and Enquiry**

You have the right to request access to and to request the correction of the personal data and other related information you supplied in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486). Such personal data requests and enquiries should be made in writing to the Electoral Registration Officer (Address: 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Treasury Building, 3 Tonkin Street West, Cheung Sha Wan, Kowloon).
