ELECTORAL AFFAIRS COMMISSION (REGISTRATION) (ELECTORS FOR LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES) (VOTERS FOR ELECTION COMMITTEE SUBSECTORS) (MEMBERS OF ELECTION COMMITTEE) REGULATION (Chapter 541B)

(Sections 25 and 29 of the Regulation)

INSPECTION OF THE 2025 PROVISIONAL REGISTER OF ELECTORS AND THE OMISSIONS LIST FOR FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES

Pursuant to sections 25 and 29 of the Electoral Affairs Commission (Registration) (Electors for Legislative Council Functional Constituencies) (Voters for Election Committee Subsectors) (Members of Election Committee) Regulation (Cap. 541B) (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulation"), it is hereby notified that—

- (a) a copy of the functional constituencies provisional register or a copy of the specific part of such provisional register; and
- (b) a copy of the functional constituencies omissions list containing the personal particulars or relevant particulars of persons who are no longer eligible to have their names included or who do not wish to remain registered in the functional constituencies register,

are now available for inspection for a purpose related to the election from 1 August to 25 August 2025 (both days inclusive) during ordinary business hours (from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) from Mondays to Fridays (other than a general holiday).

The places for inspection are as follows -

- (a) Registration and Electoral Office: 8th Floor, Treasury Building, 3 Tonkin Street West, Cheung Sha Wan, Kowloon; and
- (b) Registration and Electoral Office: 29th Floor, Standard Chartered Tower, Millennium City 1, 388 Kwun Tong Road, Kwun Tong, Kowloon.

The parts of the provisional register and the omissions list containing the names and principal residential addresses of individual electors will only be provided for inspection by specified persons¹.

Pursuant to section 25(7) of the Regulation, specified person (指明的人)—

⁽a) in relation to a functional constituencies omissions list means-

a person who is a subscriber to the Government News and Media Information System maintained by the Director of Information Services; or

 ⁽ii) a body or organization that is incorporated, or is registered or exempt from registration, under any law of Hong Kong and—

⁽A) was provided an extract under section 41(1) for a purpose related to a previous election;

⁽B) was represented by a validly nominated candidate at a previous election; or

⁽C) has publicly declared an intention to arrange for any person (including a person yet to be specified) to stand as a candidate at a coming election; and

⁽b) in relation to a functional constituencies omissions list—includes any member of the public who does not fall within paragraph (a)(i) and (ii);

Pursuant to section 29(8) of the Regulation, *specified person* (指明的人), in relation to a functional constituencies provisional register, means a person who is entitled to inspect under section 25 a copy of the omissions list prepared in compiling the register.

In accordance with sections 25(4A)(a) and 29(4A)(a) of the Regulation, only the first Chinese character (if the person's name is recorded in Chinese) or the first word (if the person's name is recorded in English) of an individual elector's name and his/her registered residential address are shown on the above provisional register of electors and omissions list to be provided for inspection by specified persons, while the relevant parts containing the registered particulars of corporate electors will be provided for inspection by members of the public.

Any person who considers that a registered person is not eligible to be registered as an elector or an authorized representative, or be registered in the part in which that person's personal particulars or relevant particulars are recorded; or that a person who has been registered as an authorized representative has been wrongly so registered, may, under section 30 of the Regulation, deliver in person² at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer not later than 25 August 2025 a notice of objection in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form.

Any person who has made an application for registration as an elector but whose personal particulars or relevant particulars are not recorded in the provisional register; or whose appointment of authorized representative was refused by the Electoral Registration Officer; or whose personal particulars or relevant particulars are included in the omissions list; or who has a claim regarding his or her or its particulars in the provisional register may, under section 31 of the Regulation, deliver in person³ at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer not later than 25 August 2025 a notice of claim in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form.

Any corporate elector which is dissatisfied with the decision of the Electoral Registration Officer not to register as an authorized representative a person appointed by that corporate as a replacement or as a substitute may, under section 31A of the Regulation, deliver by its responsible person in person at the office of the Electoral Registration Officer a notice of appeal in the specified form. The address of the office of the Electoral Registration Officer is set out in the form.

If a claimant, an objector or a person being objected to wishes to review the ruling made by the Revising Officer, he/she must submit the review application form at the office of the Registry for Appeals to Revising Officer on or before 6:00 p.m., 11 September 2025 (Thursday). Details for submission of the application are set out in the application form.
