Receipt of Electoral Mails

Q1 I would like to receive electoral mail from candidates through email. What should I do?

A1 When completing an application for voter registration, you may provide your email address and tick at the appropriate box indicating your consent to provide the email address to the candidates for the purpose of sending election mails related to electioneering activities. Registered electors may also provide or update their email address through GovHK (<u>http://www.osp.reo.gov.hk/index_e.html</u>).

Q2 What can I do if I do not wish to receive electoral mail from candidates during elections?

A2 If you do not wish to receive electoral mails from the candidate(s), you may notify the Registration and Electoral Officer with a signed notification. The notification should include the name and Hong Kong Identity Card number in full with your signature. You can send the request to this office by email (email address: gc4@reo.gov.hk), by mail (Address: 29/F, Standard Chartered Tower, Millennium City 1, 388 Kwun Tong Road, Kwun Tong, Kowloon) or by fax (Fax no.: 2574 7441). This office will convey your wish of not receiving electoral mails to the candidate(s).
